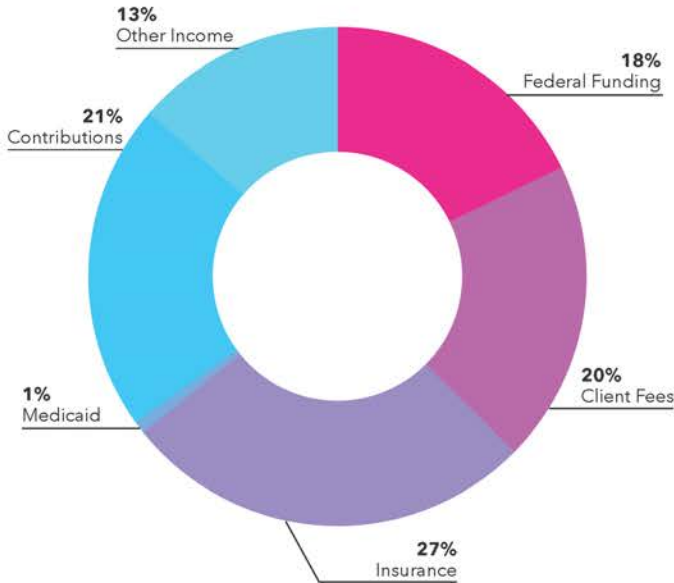

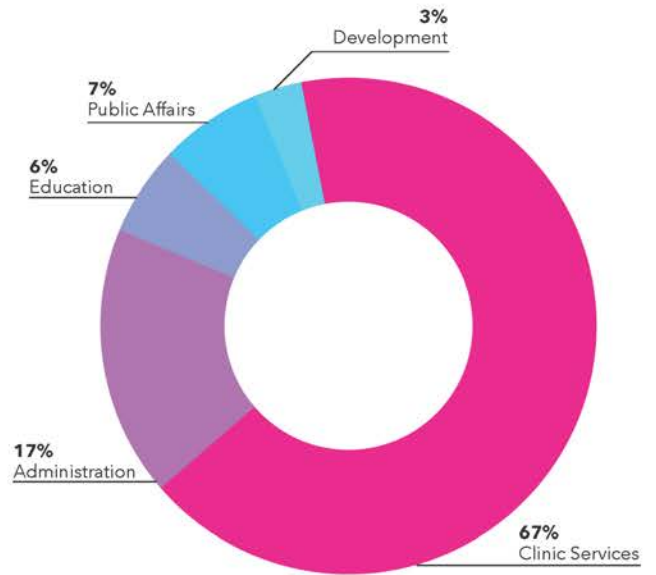

## Planned Parenthood forced out of Title X

In August 2019, the Trump administration implemented a gag rule on Title X that would have forced Planned Parenthood to withhold information about abortion services from patients. Without \$2 million in federal Title X funds, we have had to make adjustments to our fee scale and are no longer able to contract with as many rural providers to help subsidize family planning services. We continue to provide low-cost, high quality care to our patients, and all eight of our health centers remain open.
